FROM THE PASTOR

October is traditionally Mount Zion's time to focus on stewardship. We generally associate the term stewardship with money, and how we handle the resources God entrusts us with is part of it. But, stewardship encompasses much more. I like to think about stewardship as a comprehensive commitment of all we are, not just what we have. The membership vow specifically mentions five avenues through which we express that commitment: prayers, presence, gifts, service, and witness. "Calling people higher" means encouraging spiritual growth through these avenues. Each one is designed by God as a path to greater Christ-likeness. Each one is what John Wesley called a "means to grace".

To me, one of the greatest dangers to the Christian life is complacency, which is, becoming satisfied with wherever we are in our relationship with Christ rather than continually developing, deepening, and strengthening that relationship. A verse of Scripture that has come up several times in the last month or so at various church meetings is Romans 12:11. This is how J. B. Phillips translates it: *Let us not allow slackness to spoil our work and let us keep the fires of the spirit burning, as we do our work for God.* That's what our focus will be this October.

At the conclusion of the series we will have the opportunity to renew our personal commitments to God through our church in the coming year. We will consecrate these commitments in the worship service on October 30th. It will also be a special service because our worship will include a celebration of what God has done through Mount Zion in the past year and casting vision for what he wants us to do in the year ahead.

Q: What's the Yam Jam?

A: The Yam Jam is an event brought to you by the Society of St. Andrew, America's Gleaning Network. Hundreds of volunteers meet at a sweet potato field to collect the food that cannot be sold but is still edible. We bag it into ten-pound bags, load it into cars, pick-up trucks and delivery trucks, and send it out to people in need in the Triangle and beyond! In 2010, with the help of over 800 volunteers, we collected over 84,000 pounds of sweet potatoes and sent it to over 30 emergency food relief agencies and non-profits around the Triangle.

Q: Where is it?

A: We will know the exact location of the field the week of the event, but the general location is near the community of Four Oaks in Johnston County.

Q: What should I bring?

A: You should bring water, gloves, and food for yourself and your group. We will provide the bags to collect the sweet potatoes.

Q: What else do I need to know?

- You need to know that there are NO BATHROOMS in the middle of a farm field, so plan a pit stop beforehand.
- Kids are permitted to volunteer but they must be supervised by an adult.
- If you want, you can deliver sweet potatoes with your car or pick-up truck, just let us know!
